PROPOSED HIGHWAY WORKS IN YOUR AREA

LOCATION: - May Grove Charlton Marshall

Further to our previous correspondence, a programme change means we unfortunately have had to change proposed dates of the planned closure for maintenance works on the above site.

The road will now be closed between the **14th and 18th November 2025.** All other information will remain the same as below. Any previously agreed adjustments will stand for the new dates.

The road will be closed daily, between the hours of **08:00** and **18:00**, and will be re-opened to traffic overnight.

We will be carrying out targeted and localised repairs to sections of those roads highlighted in red on the attached map. For the health and safety of all parties, vehicular and pedestrian access is only available by calling the telephone number listed on our onsite signage. This will allow residents to be escorted safely on and off site by a Traffic Management Operative.

During the closure periods there will be no on street parking available, and temporary parking restrictions will be implemented to prevent waiting or parking on the roads listed above. Please note that any vehicle waiting in contravention of temporary parking restrictions may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986. If a vehicle has been removed, the owner must contact the Council's vehicle recovery contractor: Ashleywood Recovery Ltd/Bride Valley Recovery Ltd on 01305 889421.

We would like to apologise for any inconvenience caused to you as a result of this change.

These works will be carried out by Colas Ltd and Dorset Highways on behalf of Dorset Council.
